**NOTEWORTHY:** All nine Pac-10 institutions that sponsor women's swimming (Oregon does not) will compete in the Swimming Championships...Arizona, Arizona State, California, Stanford, UCLA and USC will field entrants in the Diving Championship...Individual results of the Diving Championship will enter into the team scoring of the Swimming Championships under the 24-place scoring system (30-27-26-25-24-23, etc.)...There is no team title in diving.

**LET'S TAKE A LOOK:** Stanford, winner of all four previous Pac-10 team titles, again looks to be the favorite for the team title...The Cardinal holds the national No. 1 ranking after knocking off previous number one and defending national champion, Texas on February 8...No. 3 California, No. 5 USC and No. 6 UCLA are expected to lodge a battle for the runner-up spot...A team-by-team breakdown follows...

**ARIZONA:** Junior *Crissy Ahmann-Leighton* and senior *Cheryl Simmons* lead the Wildcats into the Championships...Ahmann, a member of the U.S. National Team and the 1989 Pac-10 100 fly champion, has already recorded a school record and nation-leading 53.73 in the event...Simmons, who was second in the 1650 free and sixth in the 500 free at the Pac-10 last season, is a contender for the Pac-10 title in either event...Junior *Kelli King* is much improved this season, already recording personal bests in the 100 breast (1:02.78) and 200 breast (2:17.34)...Junior *Judi O'Leary*, fourteenth at the 1990 NCAA meet in the 100 and 200 back, leads the Cats with times of 58.51 and 2:02.91 respectively...Coach *Frank Busch* is in his second year of coaching both the men's and women's programs at Arizona, after coaching at Cincinnati for ten seasons...The Wildcats were 14th at last year's NCAA meet and have finished sixth in all four previous Pac-10 Championships.

**ARIZONA STATE:** Ranked No. 16 in the country, the experienced Sun Devils are led by returning all-American seniors, *Heidi Hendricks*, *Nancy Osborne*, and *Therese Lundin*...Hendricks, a three-event Pac-10 finalist in 1990 meet, leads the Devils in three events (50 free, 100 breaststroke, 200 IM)...Osborne, a key relay swimmer, looks to also score a bundle of individual points in the sprints...Lundin, an Arizona native, has already made the NCAA standard in the 100 butterfly (55.50)...Junior all-American diver *Janae Lautenschlager* was the one meter runner-up last season but has title hopes this year having scored 321.30 on the 1M already this year...Sophomore newcomer *Baukje Wiersma*, a member of the Dutch National Team, gives the Devils strength in the distance events leading the squad in the 200 (1:50.95), 500 (4:54.84) and 1650 freestyle (16:39.94)...The relays have always been a strength of the Sun Devils, as two quartets

finished in the top eight at the NCAA last season...Although the Devils have won the Pac-10 200 free relay two of the past four seasons, ASU has never had an individual swimming champion...ASU finished fourth as a team in the 1990 Pac-10 Championship.

**CALIFORNIA:** The Golden Bears, ranked third in the country, return sophomore all-American *Trina Radke* and senior *Sarah Anderson*, last year's Pac-10 winner in the 200 free and a three-time all-American...Radke, fifth in the 200 fly at the Seoul Olympics, has been swimming fast already recording personal bests this season in the 100 (55.72) and 200 fly (1:58.08)...Anderson has been a consistent dual meet scorer for the Bears and leads her squad in the 200 (1:48.15), 500 (4:44.48), and 1650 freestyle (16:22.64)...Another senior, three-time all-American *Carol Felton* looks to improve upon her fifth place finish in the 400 IM from last year...Junior diver *Jill Campbell* will be defending her 1990 platform title...The Bears are especially strong in the sprints with *Amy Tidball* and *Sharon Scott* having already made their NCAA cuts...*JoAnna Jensen* and *Joyce Murphy* joined Scott and Tidball in the 200 free relay in setting a new school record last December...The Bears, who were fourth at last season's NCAA Championships, have finished as the Pac-10 runner-up the past three years, after placing fifth in 1987.

**OREGON STATE:** The Beavers are led by *Lisa van Loben Sels*, a returning top ten finisher in the 50 free (fourth)...Van Loben Sels has gone 24.21 in the 50 free this season and 52.80 in the 100...Juniors *Kelly Kaplan* (freestyle) and *Tammy Scott* (freestyle/breastroke) also have an excellent chance to score some points for the Beavers...Coach *Julie Saunders* brought in a strong freshman class led by backstrokers *Tori Eisenbeis* and *Christy Ryerson* and butterfly/IMer *Julie Himstreet*...OSU was ninth at the inaugural Pac-10 Championships and came in eighth in '88, '89, and '90.

**STANFORD:** The Cardinal finished the dual meet season undefeated and ranked #1 in the country ...The 1990 NCAA runner-up is led by a number of returning all-Americans, most notably 1990 Pac-10 Swimmer of the Year and defending NCAA champion in the 500 free, 1650 free and 400 IM *Janet Evans*...Sophomore Evans, holder of three world records and three-time 1988 Olympic gold medalist, was a sensation at last year's NCAA winning three titles and setting three NCAA and two American records along the way...Sharing the high point award with Evans at last year's NCAA meet was *Janel Jorgensen*...Jorgensen, a gold medalist at the 1990 Goodwill Games and silver medalist at the 1988 Olympics, was also a three event champion at the 1990 NCAA and leads her squad in six events this season....Senior co-captain and three-time all-American *Suzy Buckovich* is back in hopes of recapturing the Pac-10 200 IM title she won in 1988...Swimming very well this season (1:02.53-100 breast; 2:15.80-200 breast) is sophomore *Lori Heisick*, last season's Pac-10 100 and 200 breaststroke champion and NCAA runner up in both breaststroke events...Freshman phenom *Summer Sanders* is making her collegiate debut this season after winning three gold medals in last summer's Goodwill Games...A very versatile swimmer, Sanders leads the Cardinal in the 200 fly (1:57.98) and 400 IM (4:13.61)...Stanford has won all four Pac-10 team titles, its highest point total coming last season (1717.0)...Although runner-up at last year's NCAA meet, the Cardinal won the 1983 and 1989 NCAA team crowns, making Stanford only the second institution to win multiple NCAA women's swimming titles (Texas has won six)...The Cardinal has won 40 individual and thirteen relay titles in four previous Pac-10 Championships...Stanford has never finished lower than third at either the NCAA or AIAW Championships.

**UCLA:** Coach *Cyndi Gallagher's* Bruins hold down the No. 6 national ranking...Junior *Kristin Stoudt*, sophomore *Christy Richardson*, and senior *Sheri Smith* lead UCLA into this year's Pac-10...Stoudt, a seven-event all-American last season, has posted quality times already this season in the 100 fly (55.54) and 100 free (51.20)...Richardson, a breaststroke specialist, was also a seven-event all-American in '89 and looks to score high in this year's Championship...Smith, a current Bruin record holder, was a three-event finalist at last year's Pac-10 meet and a three-time all-American...More importantly, Smith, Richardson and Stoudt play major roles in the make-up of the historically strong Bruin relays...Sophomore *Jeanne Gibbons*, runner-up in the 200 free at the 1990 Pac-10, looks to score more points at this year's meet...Leading the freshman corps are *Kristy Heydanek* and *Becky Bruch*...Heydanek leads the Bruin squad in the 100 (57.13) and 200 backstroke (2:04.62)...Bruch, a breastroker/IMer, enters the Pac-10 meet with season bests of 2:17.38 in the 200 breast and 4:28.14 in the 400 IM...The Bruins have finished third in all four previous Pac-10 Championships...Last year UCLA finished 5th at the NCAA.

**USC:** Senior co-captain *Lisa Dorman* leads the No. 5 Trojans into this year's meet...Dorman, a three-time all-American, has been very tough all season, already setting a school record in the 50 free (23.15)...Juniors *Anna Hansen* and *Leslie Seward* should provide strength in many areas for the Trojans...Hansen, a Swedish native, swam personal bests in the 100 fly (56.68) and 200 IM (2:03.10) while Seward, a two-time All-American, has qualified for the NCAA in the 50 free (23.26) and 100 breast (1:03.50)... *Sheri White*, the national high school record holder in the 100 back (56.00) leads the USC sophomore class...White, Pac-10 runner-up in 1990, is a definite contender in the 100 back with a season best of 55.92...Sophomore *Tara Shriner* broke her own school record in the 100 breast (1:03.18) this season and should score high in her specialty...Coach *Darrell Fick* brought in a strong freshman class led by backstrokers *Heather Ray* and *Diana Fridley*...Ray already swam her personal bests in the 100 and 200 back (56.86, 2:01.67) as did Fridley (57.04, 2:02.55)...The Trojans were second at the 1987 Pac-10's, fourth in 1988 and 1989, and fifth in 1990.

**WASHINGTON:** Sophomore *Jenny Nixon* and freshmen *Michelle Murray* and *Tiffany Taradash* highlight the Husky contingent...Nixon, a scorer at the 1990 Pac-10 leads the squad in the 500 (5:09.96) and 1000 free (10:38.48)...Murray, a Washington native, has already swum fast times in the 200 free (1:53.45) and 200 fly (1:12.95)...Taradash comes in with season bests of (59.18) in the 100 back and (2:09.18) in the 200 back. All three will combine to swim on a number of the Husky relay foursomes...Washington has finished seventh in all four of the previous Pac-10 Championships...Although Washington is hosting the Championships, they will not be held on the campus but rather at the Weyerhaeuser King County Aquatic Center, site of the 1990 Goodwill Games.

**WASHINGTON STATE:** A trio of sophomores, *Kelly Kocur*, *Kim Taylor* and *Anjanette Wong* lead the very young Cougar team which lists only one senior on its roster...Wong has set a school record in the 400 IM (4:37.85), while Kocur and Taylor lead the squad in butterfly and backstroke respectively...Other school records set this season include *Jessica Adophson* in the 50 free (23.95) and *Linda Dobbels* in the 100 breaststroke (1:07.56)...The Cougars have finished ninth at the last three Pac-10 Championships, after placing eighth in 1987.

## NO. 1 STANFORD WOMEN WIN FIFTH STRAIGHT PAC-10 SWIMMING TITLE

FEDERAL WAY, Wash.--Sophomore Janet Evans won the 1,650-yard freestyle Saturday, giving her three women's Pacific-10 Conference titles, and top-ranked Stanford continued its monopoly of the team title with its fifth consecutive championship.

Stanford amassed 1,640 points, 276 more than nearest rival, California. The No. 3-ranked Golden Bears were second for the third year in a row, recording their highest point total ever with 1,364 points. UCLA had 1,221 points to place third.

The Cardinal has won every conference team championship since the Pac-10 began sponsoring women's swimming in 1987.

The team point totals include three women's diving events, the 1-meter, 3-meter and platform events, contested in Los Angeles during the same three-day span as the swimming.

Evans, the Pac-10 record holder in the 1,650-yard event, easily outdistanced the field, winning by 18.18 seconds with a time of 16-minutes, 2.92-seconds. California's Sarah Anderson was second, completing the race in 16:21.15.

Evans advances to the NCAA championships, March 21-23 in Indianapolis, Indiana to defend her 1,650 freestyle national title. A three-time gold medalist at the 1988 Seoul Olympic Games, Evans claimed three conference crowns for the second straight year. She won the 500 freestyle on Thursday and the 400 individual medley Friday. Evans is also the reigning NCAA champion in those three events.

Matching Evans' three-event triumph was Arizona's Chrissy Ahman-Leighton who took top honors in the 100-yard freestyle Saturday. She edged UCLA's Kristin Stoudt, the defending titlist and meet record holder, by 0.79 seconds with a time of 50.11.

Ahman-Leighton won the 50-yard freestyle Thursday and Friday claimed the 100-yard butterfly title.

Stanford swept the top three places in the 200-yard butterfly, led by freshman Summer Sanders who set a meet record with a time of 1:57.39. She eclipsed the mark of 1:57.54 established by Mary T. Meagher in 1987.

Janel Jorgensen, the defending 1990 champion, was second in 1:58.67. The 1989 Pac-10 titlist, Michelle Griglione, was third at 2:00.09.

Cardinal swimmers won eight of 13 individual events and two of five relays. Stanford won the final event of the meet, the 800-yard freestyle.

Other Stanford individual winners Saturday were Lori Heisick who won her second straight 200-yard breaststroke crown, and Dede Trimble who won the 200-yard backstroke.

UW senior Christie Geist, a product of Newport High School, concluded her collegiate career with a 23rd-place performance in the 200-yard butterfly. She completed the race in a career-best time of 2:10.20, shaving 3.41 seconds off her previous best.

## CAL'S ANDERSON WINS THIRD PAC-10 CROWN, STANFORD MAINTAINS TEAM LEAD

FEDERAL WAY, Wash.--California's Sarah Anderson won her third consecutive Pacific-10 Conference 200-yard freestyle swimming title Friday, but the second-place Golden Bears fell even further behind four-time defending team champion Stanford at the King County Aquatics Center.

Anderson, a senior, saved her best race for her final Pac-10 meet appearance. She completed the 200 yards in a meet record time of 1-minute, 47.67 seconds, easily defeating runner-up Anna Hansen of USC by 1.46 seconds.

Top-ranked Stanford owns a commanding 198-point lead over No. 3 California, amassing 1,095 points, including scores from two diving events contested in Los Angeles. The Bears have 897 points and UCLA is third with 818.5.

Stanford sophomore Janet Evans won the 400-yard individual medley, an event in which she holds the NCAA record. Evans, who suffered her first 400 I.M. loss at this same sight to teammate Summer Sanders at the Goodwill Games in July, outdistanced the Pac-10 field by 1.23 seconds. She finished with a time of 4:18.05.

Sanders who swam the fastest preliminary time in the 400 I.M., elected not to compete in the final. California's Lorenza Munoz finished second to Evans for the second straight year.

The most competitive race of the day was the 100-yard breaststroke where seven of the eight finalists reached the qualifying standard for the NCAA championship meet, March 21-23 in Indianapolis, Indiana.

Lori Heisick of Stanford defended her 100-breaststroke title, edging Arizona's Kelli King by 0.08 seconds with a winning time of 1:03.15.

Arizona's Chrissy Ahman-Leighton, a winner in the 50-yard freestyle Thursday, won the 100-yard butterfly in 53.62 seconds. Defending champion Janel Jorgensen of Stanford was second in 54.45.

Kristy Heydanek became UCLA's first individual winner, taking top honors in the 100-yard backstroke in 56.39 seconds.

Stanford won its first relay title of the meet, posting a time of 7:17.75 in the 800-yard freestyle relay. UCLA won the 200-yard medley relay in 1:43.45.

The Pac-10 meet concludes Saturday with six swimming finals.

Washington freshman Tiffany Taradash finished 11th in the 100-yard backstroke with a time of 59.00. That matched the highest finish for a UW swimmer since the Pac-10 women's meet was first contested in 1987. She equalled Helen Johnson's 11th-place 400 I.M. performance in 1987.

FEDERAL WAY, Wash.--Stanford's No. 1-ranked women's swimming team opened a considerable first-day lead in the Pacific-10 Conference championship meet that featured a dead-heat finish in the 200-yard individual medley Thursday at the King County Aquatics Center.

Janel Jorgensen of Stanford, the defending 200 I.M. titlist, technically retained her crown, but must share it with freshman teammate Summer Sanders. Both Cardinal swimmers finished in 2-minutes, 0.38 seconds, a new Pac-10 meet record. Susan Johnson made it a Stanford sweep, placing third in 2:03.33.

Point totals from the women's diving competition, contested in Los Angeles during the same three-day span as the swimming, count toward determining the women's Pac-10 team champion. Stanford earned first-place points in the 3-meter diving as Eileen Richetelli amassed 496.20 points.

The four-time defending champion Cardinal has 501 points to take a 116-point lead over second place California. The Golden Bears, ranked third nationally, have 385 points. UCLA is third with a score of 314.5.

Stanford sophomore Janet Evans, a three-time gold medalist at the 1988 Seoul Olympics, successfully defended her 500-yard freestyle title. Evans completed the race in 4:44.07, 2.44 seconds ahead of Arizona State's Baukie Wiersma. Eva Mortenson of Stanford was third.

Arizona's Chrissy Ahman-Leighton broke the Cardinal monopoly of individual titles, winning the 50-yard freestyle event with a time of 23.22. UCLA's Kristin Stoudt and Lisa Dorman of USC tied for second at 23.47.

Arizona also garnered first-place points in the 400-yard medley relay, outswimming Stanford by 1.48 seconds with a time of 3:44.53.

UCLA won the 200-yard freestyle relay in 1:33.66, edging the Cardinal by 0.21 seconds.

The women's championships continue through Saturday.

# Texas women win with strong finish

Texas finished strong March 23 and won the team title at the Division I Women's Swimming and Diving Championships—its second straight team title and seventh in the last eight years.

After two days, Stanford held a six-point lead over Texas, 461-455. But Longhorn coach Mark Schubert felt his team had the strength to take the title. "The final day is our best day," he said after competition March 22 at the Indiana University Natatorium in Indianapolis. His words proved prophetic. The Longhorns finished with 746 points, nearly 100 better than Stanford.

"It was close," Schubert said. "I feel like the team came together today (March 23). It was the best night session we've had since I've been coaching here. The reason I came to Texas is because I felt Texas has the tradition. I told the team tonight it was up to them to carry out that tradition."

Stanford freshman Summer Sanders set meet records in three events (including an American record in the 200-yard individual medley), swam a leg of the winning 400-yard medley relay and earned Division I swimmer of the year honors.

"I was really unsure how I was going to do coming into the meet. I get like this sometimes. I was standing on the blocks not thinking about how the team was doing or how I was going to do. My mind was just a complete blank. Maybe it's better," Sanders said.

Southern Methodist swept the rest of the awards. Steve Collins was named Division I swimming coach of the year. Jim Stillson was named Division I diving coach of the year, and Krista Wilson was

## PACIFIC-10 CONFERENCE WOMEN'S SWIMMING HONORS

In a vote by the Conference coaches, Stanford's **Summer Sanders** and Arizona's **Crissy Ahmann-Leighton** have been named Pac-10 co-Swimmers of the Year and Arizona's **Frank Busch** has been named Coach of the Year, Commissioner Thomas C. Hansen announced today.

Last month in Indianapolis, Sanders won NCAA titles in the 200 individual medley (1:57.02), 400 individual medley (4:05.19) and 200 butterfly (1:54.17). The Roseville, Calif., native won Pac-10 titles in the 400 IM and tied with Janel Jorgensen for the 200 IM title, setting meet records in both events. Only a freshman, Sanders set meet records in all three events and an American record in the 200 IM. Sanders burst onto the international scene last summer when she won three gold medals in three events at the Goodwill Games.

At the NCAA meet in Indianapolis, Ahmann-Leighton set a new American, U.S. Open, and NCAA record in the 100 fly (52.36), breaking the old mark of 52.42 set by Mary T. Meagher of California. She also was third in the 50 (22.90) and 100 free (49.36). A junior out of Benson, Ariz., Ahmann-Leighton won three events and set three meet records at the 1991 Pac-10 Championships. She represented the United States at the World Championships in January 1991 placing fourth in the 100 meter fly.

Second year coach Frank Busch helped the Wildcats jump an incredible eight places in one year with a seventh place finish at this year's NCAA meet. That marked the first time Arizona had been in the top ten since 1982. The Wildcat women were also fifth at the Pac-10 Championships, their highest finish ever. Prior to coming to Tucson, Busch served a head men's and women's swimming coach at the University of Cincinnati for eight years twice having been named the Metro Conference Women's Coach of the Year.
