THE TEAMS . . . STANFORD enters the Ninth Annual Pac-10 Championships ranked as the nation's top team, undefeated for the seventh-straight season at 8-0 overall . . . After disposing of No. 2 Michigan 149-147 in a dual meet earlier this season, the top-ranked Cardinal are aiming for their fourth straight NCAA title and fifth in 12 years . . . The Cardinal will defend a Pac-10 title whose trophy they have held since the first Pac-10 Women's Championship Meet in 1987 . . . USC will be Stanford's toughest competition, as the third-ranked Women of Troy are 8-1 . . . Earlier this season, USC fell to Stanford 192-107 . . . Three additional Pac-10 teams - No. 8 ARIZONA, No. 10 UCLA and CALIFORNIA.

LAST YEAR . . . STANFORD won its eighth consecutive Pac-10 title and moved on to claim its third consecutive NCAA crown . . . USC true freshman **Kristin Quance**, the Pac-10 Swimmer of the Year, set an NCAA and Pac-10 record in the 200 breast with a time of 2:09.88 . . . Quance also won the 100 breast at the Pac-10 meet, while Stanford's **Jenny Thompson** set a meet record in the 50 free and teammate **Lea Loveless** (1990-94) notched two meet marks (100 back — 53.00/200 back — 1:54.13) . . . MEN'S OUTLOOK . . . Two of the Pac-10's all-time top divers will be absent from this year's competition, including USC's Brian Earley, who rewrote the Pac-10 record book in all three diving events and UCLA's David Fleck, who finished second in both the three-meter and the platform, and third in the one-meter behind Earley . . . STANFORD senior Jamie Edwards and ARIZONA junior Andre Sabbah headline the pool of talent at this year's competition . . . Edwards finished second in the one-meter and fourth in the three-meter in 1994, while Sabbah placed fifth in the one-meter and third in the three-meter . . . Cardinal junior David Johns is the returning favorite in the platform event, as he finished third behind Earley and Fleck last year . . . Arizona senior Brian Spears is an all-around competitor and heavy contender in all events . . . Spears, who won the three-meter in 1993, finished fourth in the one-meter, sixth in the three-meter and fourth in platform as a junior in 1994.

WOMEN'S OUTLOOK . . . After taking a medical redshirt last season, Stanford senior Eileen Richetelli is a strong favorite to place tops in all events . . . Richetelli is a two-time NCAA Diver of the Year, a four-time NCAA Champion and an eight-time All-American . . . In the Pac-10s, Richetelli won the one-meter and three-meter as a freshman, won the three-meter and platform as a sophomore and then the platform as a junior . . . 1994 platform champ Amy Palmer of Arizona State returns for her senior farewell and a shot at defending her title . . . Missing from this year's competition is former UCLA standout Kristen Walls, two-time defending one-and-three meter champion . . . Added pressure will come from Arizona State senior Amy Garner, who finished as a runner-up to Walls in both the one- and three-meter last year . . . Also look for junior Mary Elena Romero of USC, junior Jennifer Cnota of ASU, and the Cardinal's sophomore trio of Britt Mattern, Megan Gardner and Stefanie Forrest to add heat to the fire.

STANFORD'S BRIAN RETTERER, JENNY THOMPSON AND ARIZONA STATE'S BEATA KASZUBA NAMED PAC-10 SWIMMERS OF THE YEAR, STANFORD COACHES KENNEY AND QUICK HONORED

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. – In a vote of Pac-10 Conference coaches, STANFORD senior Brian Retterer has been named the 1994-95 Pacific-10 Conference Men's Swimmer of the Year, while ARIZONA STATE junior Beata Kaszuba and STANFORD senior Jenny Thompson have been named the 1994-95 Pacific-10 Conference Women's Co-Swimmers of the Year, Commissioner Tom Hansen announced today.

Stanford's men's and women's head coaches swept Pac-10 honors, as Skip Kenney was named Men's Coach of the Year and Richard Quick was named Women's Coach of the Year.

Retterer, a senior from Sparks, Nev., led the three-time defending NCAA Champions to a second place finish at the 1995 NCAA Championships and the team's 13th-consecutive top-five NCAA finish. Retterer shattered American, U.S. Open, NCAA and school records with two of Stanford's four individual titles with wins in the 100 and 200 backstrokes. With a 45.43 time in the 100-yard back, Retterer broke his own 1994 record-best performance. In the 200-yard back, the All-American finished with a record-setting 1:40.61 time.

Retterer also contributed to four of the Cardinal's five relay victories at the NAAs - the most victories for a Stanford squad since the team won five in 1992. Stanford's 400 medley relay broke the American record set by the 1992 Cardinal team. Retterer swam the lead leg for the 200 and 400 medley relay first-place squads, as well as swimming for the first-place 200 and 400 freestyle relay teams and the second-place 800 freestyle relay squad.

Retterer finished his senior season with four NCAA titles (100 back twice, 50 free, 200 back) and scored 55 points for the second year in a row. Retterer scored a total of 178 points as a Cardinal swimmer at the NAAs - fourth-best on Stanford's all-time list. Retterer finished off his Pac-10 career by winning the 100 back (46.82), the 200 back (1:43.62), fifth in the 50 free (20.31) and contributed to team first-place wins in the 200 free relay, 200 medley relay and 400 medley relay. The Stanford's men's swimming squad garnered its' 14th-straight Pac-10 title, breaking the Pac-10 record for consecutive championships in a sport.

Kaszuba, a junior from Poznan, Poland, set a U.S. Open and two NCAA meet records in the 100 and 200 breaststrokes. For her performance at the NAAs, Kaszuba was named NCAA Swimmer of the Year as she helped Arizona State to a 14th-place finish. In the 100-yard breast, she took nearly a second off the mark she set last year with a 59.71 record-setting time (1994: 1:00.46). Her performance in the 100-yard breast marked the first time a woman swimmer finished the race in under a minute. Kaszuba then recorded a 2:09.71 in the 200-yard breast and topped the previous NCAA-best set by USC's Kristine Quance last year (1994: 2:10.69).

Kaszuba, a three-time All-American, won two Pac-10 events at this year's championships and helped her team to a fourth-place finish. Collecting 85 individual points at the Pac-10s, she captured the 100-yard breast in 1:01.61 and took the 200-yard breast with a 2:12.32 finish. Kaszuba was also a member of Arizona State's first place 400-yard medley relay team that had a time of 3:45.23.

Thompson, a senior from Dover, N.H., won five NCAA titles (three individual, two relay) in her last collegiate meet to lead the Cardinal to their fourth-straight national title. At the NCAAs, she captured the 100 free, 100 fly and 200 IM, while also helping two relay squads (200 medley relay and 400 free relay) to victory. In the 200 IM race, Thompson posted a personal-best time of 1:57.63 and captured top individual scoring honors (60 points) for the first time in her career. A senior on the Stanford squad, she compiled a perfect four-year run, capturing all four NCAA titles, all four Pac-10 crowns and posting a 27-0 dual meet record for the Cardinal.

The two-time Olympic gold medalist completed her collegiate career with 19 total NCAA titles (nine individual and 10 relay) and 26 All-American honors. The 19 NCAA titles is the most ever by an individual in women's collegiate swimming and diving and her nine individual victories ranks second on the all-time NCAA list. With all four NCAA 100 free crowns under her belt, Thompson is only the fifth woman in NCAA history to win a single event four-straight years. She is also a three-time first-team All-Academic Pac-10 selection.

At the Pac-10 Championships, Thompson claimed six conference titles. She won three individual events (100 free, 100 fly and 200 IM) and anchored three relay squads to victory (400 free relay, 800 free relay and 200 medley relay). The 1995 Co-Swimmer of the Year concluded her Pac-10 career with 26 total Conference titles (11 individual and 15 relay), including all four 100 free individual titles.

In 16 years as Stanford's head men's swim coach, Kenney has won six NCAA titles and this season captured an unprecedented 14th-consecutive Pac-10 Championship. Kenney has been named NCAA Coach of the Year five times and has won Pac-10 Coach of the Year honors nine times.

Kenney has coached 107 Pac-10 champions and 67 NCAA individual and relay champions in 16 years of coaching at Stanford. At the helm for the Cardinal, he holds a 140-25 (.849) career dual meet record, including a perfect 25-1 mark in the past three seasons. In recognition of his coaching success, Kenney has been named head men's swimming coach for the 1996 Olympic Games in Atlanta.

In seven years as Stanford's head women's swimming coach, Quick has guided Stanford to its fourth-straight and fifth overall NCAA title in the last seven years. In addition, Quick has coached Stanford to seven-straight Pacific-10 Conference crowns, nine-straight Pac-10 titles overall. He has never lost a dual meet with the Cardinal, sporting a perfect 51-0 mark.

Quick is responsible for coaching 62 All-Americans to 387 All-American honors in his 18 seasons of coaching at the college level. In seven seasons at Stanford, he has helped develop 22 NCAA champions who have captured a combined 38 NCAA individual and 16 relay titles. In recognition of his coaching success, Quick has been named the head women's swimming coach for the 1996 Olympic Games in Atlanta.

STANFORD SWEEPS PAC-10 AWARDS AS EILEEN RICHELLETTI AND DAVID JOHNS NAMED PAC-10 DIVERS OF THE YEAR, COACH RICH SCHAVONE EARNS COACH OF THE YEAR HONORS

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- In a vote of Pac-10 Conference coaches, STANFORD senior Eileen Richetelli has been named the 1994-95 Pacific-10 Conference Women's Diver of the Year, while fellow Cardinal senior David Johns has been named the 1994-95 Pacific-10 Conference Men's Diver of the Year, Commissioner Tom Hansen announced today.

Stanford head coach Rich Schavone was named Pac-10 Men's and Women's Coach of the Year.

Richetelli, a senior from Milford, Conn., won the platform, took third in the three-meter and fifth in the one-meter diving competitions at the NAAs. For the four-time defending NCAA champion Cardinal, she won the platform diving event with a career-best 630.10-point total. A two-time NCAA Diver of the Year, Richetelli closed out her career with five NCAA titles, including three wins in the platform venue.

Richetelli earned Most Valuable Women's Diver honors at the Pac-10 meet, winning the three-meter and platform venues and taking second in the one-meter competition. For the four-time defending Pac-10 champs, she was the top individual point scorer at the Pac-10s, scoring 87 points.

Johns, a junior from Springfield, Va., earned Most Valuable Men's Diver honors at the Pac-10 Championships. For the 14-time defending Pac-10 champion Cardinal, Johns won the platform event and placed second in both the one- and three-meter venues. At the NAAs where three-time defending NCAA champion Stanford placed second, Johns finished 16th in the platform venue.

Schavone, in his 16th year on The Farm as men's and women's diving coach, guided both squads to strong finishes at both the NAAs and Pac-10s. At the NAAs, the 1992 NCAA Diving Coach of the Year coached two individuals to four All-American honors in women's diving. Overall, Schavone has coached four NCAA champions. At the Pac-10s, his divers took five of six events as Richetelli won two, Johns nabbed one and Cardinal senior James Edwards earned top honors in the one- and three-meter finals.

Stanford swimmers win last two events to claim another I women's title

Stanford won the final two events of the Division I Women's Swimming and Diving Championships to vault past Michigan and earn a fourth consecutive team title March 16-18 at Texas.

Stanford trailed by 21 points before senior Eileen Richetelli, who missed competition last year with a back injury, won the platform diving competition to help the Cardinal compile 32 points in the event. Stanford then won the final event, the 400-yard freestyle relay, while Michigan placed third. Stanford's total of 497½ points was 19 better than Michigan, which represented the

closest margin of victory since Texas defeated Stanford by 9½ points in 1990.

Richetelli, who won the platform and three-meter diving events in 1992 and 1993, was part of a Cardinal diving contingent that scored 66 points in the three diving events, while Michigan scored none. The Wolverines' top diver, Carrie Zarse, finished 13th in both the three-meter and platform events last year, but was absent this year to compete in the Pan American Games.

Michigan was vying for its first crown and had overcome a slight Stanford margin to build a 15-point lead heading into the final day of competition. Alecia Humphrey led

Her win in the 100-yard freestyle on the final day was her fourth consecutive in the event, making her the fifth swimmer in championships history to accomplish that feat. Thompson then swam the anchor leg in the Cardinal's 400-yard freestyle relay victory to close out the meet.

Beata Kaszuba of Arizona State, Ashley Tappin of Arizona and Florida's Mimosa McNerney joined Thompson and Humphrey as multiple-event winners. Kaszuba set a U.S. Open and two meet records in the 100- and 200-yard breaststrokes and was named swimmer of the meet. She took nearly a second off the mark she set last year in the 100-yard breaststroke, then topped the previous best in the 200-yard breaststroke set by Southern California's Kristine Quance last year.

Tappin, who transferred from Florida, won the 50- and 200-yard freestyles and finished second behind Thompson in the 100-yard freestyle. McNerney, who won the 1,650-yard freestyle in 1993, won that event again this year along with the 500-yard freestyle.

Southern Methodist's Cheril Sanhni won the one-meter dive after finishing second in that event last year, then placed second in the three-meter and third in the platform event and was named diver of the meet.

Michigan was the first team other than Stanford, Texas or Florida to finish in the top three. Texas finished third this year, while Southern Methodist edged Arizona for fourth place.
