LAST YEAR: USC diver Dorte Linder claimed 1998 Pac-10 Diver of the Year on the women's side, after winning the one (420.45) and three-meter (540.15) individual championships at the Pac-10 meet in Tempe, Arizona. Her score in the three-meter is a Pac-10 record. Kim Powers of Stanford claimed the platform title (359.95). For the men, USC's Justin Dumais was named Diver of the Year after winning the triple crown at the Conference Championships. Dumais set Pac-10 records in winning the one (576.00) and three-meter (611.45) titles. He claimed the platform title as well with a score of 467.65. USC coach Jeff Shaffer earned his first Pac-10 Diving Coach of the Year honor for after coaching both the men and women to impressive finishes at the Conference meet.

NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS: The NCAA Women's Diving Championships will take place Thursday through Saturday, March 18-20, in Athens, Georgia. The NCAA Men's Diving Championships will take place Thursday through Saturday, March 25-27, in Indianapolis, Indiana.

PAC-10 NOTES: The 1999 Pac-10 Championships mark the final time Pac-10 swimmers can qualify for the NCAA Championships...Five of the six Pac-10 schools are ranked in the latest CSCA Top 25 poll: No. 1 STANFORD, No. 4 USC, No. 6 ARIZONA, No. 7 CALIFORNIA and No. 12 ARIZONA STATE...Six 1998 Pac-10 Champions return to defend their titles in seven events...Three 1998 NCAA individual champions will participate in the Conference Championships...Arizona junior, and 1998 Pac-10 Swimmer of the Year, Ryk Neethling (200, 500 and 1,650 free) and Stanford seniors Tate Blahnik (200 back) and Matthew Pierce (200 fly) are all defending NCAA Champions.

ARIZONA: The Wildcats are led into competition by four-time NCAA and three-time Pac-10 Champion Ryk Neethling...Neethling, a junior, is the defending Conference champ in the 500 and 1650 free...Neethling comes into the competition as the fastest 500 freestyler in the country (4:15.70)...A threat to triple in the 200, 500 and 1650 free, as he did at the 1998 NCAA Championships...SO Jay Schryver is a standout for the Wildcats in the middle distance freestyle events...Schryver is the nation's fastest 200 freestyler this season (1:35.51) and is second fastest in 100 free (43.74)...JR Matt Allen is the school record holder in both backstrokes and is currently ranked in the top three in both (100 back-47.80; 200 back-1:44.46)...SO Ben Anderson (fly), JR Rob Henikman (breast) and SR Chris Bundy (fly, breast, IM) could also score for the Cats...Ranked No. 6 in the Speedo America CSCA Poll.

ARIZONA STATE: Senior Francisco Sanchez enters the Pac-10 Championships as the top-ranked 50 (19.5) and 100 (42.95) freestyler in the nation...His time in the 100 free is nearly one second faster than the second place time...He also has the second fastest 200 free (1:35.53) and third fastest 100 fly (47.88)...Junior Pablo Abal is ranked top 25 nationally in the 100 back (49.27)...Freshman Simon MacDonald could score for the Sun Devils in the butterfly...MacDonald is top 15 nationally in the 100 fly (48.65)...The Devils are very strong in the freestyle relays...They currently have the nation's top times in the 200 free relay (1:19.21) and 400 free relay (2:55.90)...Arizona State is ranked No. 11 in the Speedo America CSCA Poll.

CALIFORNIA: Freestyle specialist Bart Kizierowski is one of the Golden Bears top hopes to bring home a Pac-10 Championship...A junior, Kizierowski is ranked in the top 15 nationally in the 50 (20.19), 100 (44.00) and 200 free (1:37.90)...Freshman Andrew Chan is expected to score in the breaststroke events...Chan is ranked among the top 5 in the 100 (54.74) and 200 breast (1:58.72)...Senior Gordan Kozulj is a jack-of-all-trades for the Bears...Kozulj has the fourth fastest 200 back (1:44.47) in the land and fifth quickest 200 IM (1:48.42), and is nationally ranked in the 100 back (49.17) and 200 fly (1:48.57)... Cal is ranked No. 7 in the Speedo America CSCA Poll.

STANFORD: Skip Kenney's Cardinal come into the Championships the No. 1 team in America...Three Pac-10 champions return in 1999...Senior Dod Wales is the defending Pac-10 champ in the 100 fly...Wales is currently ranked No. 2 nationally in the event (47.11), as well as No. 4 in the 100 free (43.90) ...Senior Blake Holden won the Conference title in the 100 breast (54.62)...He is currently ranked No. 21 in the event (2:01.66)... Glenn Counts is the other defending champ for the Card, winning the 200 IM (1:47.35) in 1998... Senior Tate Blahnik comes into the Championships as the No. 1 swimmer in the 200 back (1:42.78)...Blahnik won an NCAA title in the event last year...He is also top-ranked in the 100 back (47.76).

USC: Bela Szabados hopes to defend his Pac-10 title in the 200 free...Szabados, a senior, currently has the fourth-fastest 200 free (1:36.64) swim in the land and second-fastest 500 free (4:18.69)...His time in the 100 free (44.33) ranks in the top 15...Freshman Ryosuke Imai has made a splash in the breaststroke events...Imai has the nation's fastest swim in the 200 breast (1:57.81) and fifth-fastest in the 100 breast

(55.08)...Sophomore **Philippe Demers** figures to be a player in the free, IM and fly events...Demers time in the 200 fly (1:47.51) is eleventh fastest this year...**Mike Williams**, a senior, is a major contributor for Troy in both the free and fly sprints...Senior **Mark Kwok** should score points in the middle-distance free, IM and 200 fly, where he is ranked in the top 50 (1:49.61)...USC is ranked No. 4 in the Speedo America CSCA Poll.

WASHINGTON: First-year coach Mickey Wender leads a young Husky team into Long Beach...UW has only three seniors on its squad...**Fergus Hudson** became the school record holder in the 50 free (20.56) this season...The senior's time is ranked in the top 50...Sophomore **Francis Tam** is solid in the IM...Tam's 200 IM (1:50.38) swim is ranked No. 30 in the nation...The Huskies are very strong in the relays...All five UW relays are ranked in the top 40...Established a new school record in the 200 free relay this season (1:22.91)...That relay is 34th-fastest in the country...Ranked 27th in the 800 FR.

LAST YEAR: Stanford won its 17th consecutive Pac-10 Championship on the strength of eight individual championships and four relay wins. The Cardinal finished well ahead of runner-up USC, 962.5 to 700.5.

Pac-10 Men's Swimming Championships Come Down to Final Event *Stanford wins for 18th straight year*

LONG BEACH, Calif. -- It came down to the last event of the meet, the 400 yards freestyle relay, but Stanford was able to defend its Pac-10 Men's Swimming Championship for the 17th straight year, holding off the team from California at the 1999 Pac-10 Men's Swimming Championships in Long Beach at the Belmont Plaza Pool. Stanford's final score was 748.5 to second place California's 740.5. USC (674.0) finished third, Arizona (441.0) fourth, Arizona State (428.0) fifth and Washington (232.0) sixth.

In individual action, Arizona junior Ryk Neethling defended his Pac-10 title in the 1650 yards freestyle for the second year in a row in the first event of the evening. Neethling's swim of 15:03.02 was six seconds faster than Stanford sophomore Jeremy Kane who turned in a 15:09.31. Kane edged out teammate Reid Gustin, a freshman, who finished third at 15:09.47. Neethling, the two-time defending NCAA champion in the event, also won Pac-10 title in the 500 freestyle on Thursday. Stanford's 2-3 finish in the event put the Cardinal on top for the first time since day one, by a score of 626.5-610.5.

In the 200 yards butterfly, Stanford senior Tate Blahnik went out of the Pac-10 meet the way he came in 1996. Blahnik won the event his freshman year, and did so again his senior campaign in a time of 1:42.46. He is also the defending NCAA champion in the event. Blahnik's Stanford teammate Dan Schultz finished second at 1:44.02, barely edging out third place Gordan Kozulj of California who swam a 1:44.08.

Arizona State's Francisco Sanchez won the next event, the 100 yards freestyle, after finishing second in both the 50 free and 100 fly earlier in the meet. Sanchez's swim of 42.86 is a new Pac-10 meet record, surpassing the time of 43.07 swam earlier in the day by California senior Bart Kizierowski. Kizierowski finished second in the final at 42.94. Arizona freshman Roland Schoeman finished third at 43.56.

After trailing Stanford for two events, Cal retook the lead by 20 points, 674.5-654.5, following a 1-2 finish by junior Nuk Sirisanont and freshman Andrew Chan in the 200 yards breaststroke. The win for Sirisanont was his second of the week, after taking the 400 IM crown on Friday. Sirisanont swam a 1:57.04 followed by Chan who swam 1:58.13. Senior Blake Holden of Stanford finished third at 1:58.89.

Sophomore Phil Demers of USC claimed the title in the 200 yards butterfly with a swim of 1:45.62. Stanford sophomore's Steven Brown and Adam Messner finished second and third. Brown turned in a swim of 1:46.25, while Messner clocked a 1:46.76. With its 2-3 finished, and once the diving scores were added in, Stanford regained the lead by a mere two points, 708.5-706.5, going into the 400 yards freestyle relay.

The 400 free relay was just about as close as you can get, but Stanford's anchor Dod Wales was able to out-touch Cal's Lars Merseburg at the wall by .6 of a second. The Cardinal team Justin Ewers, Glenn Counts, Adam Messner and Wales swam 2:53.87. Second place Cal swam 2:54.45, followed in third by USC at 2:55.71.

USC's JUSTIN DUMAIS AND JEFF SHAFFER NAMED 1998-99 PAC-10 MEN'S DIVER AND COACH OF THE YEAR

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- USC's Justin Dumais and Jeff Shaffer have been named 1998-99 Pacific-10 Conference Men's Diver and Coach of the Year, Commissioner Tom Hansen announced today.

Dumais, a sophomore from Ventura, Calif., claimed the Pac-10 triple crown for the second consecutive year, winning all three individual diving events at the Pac-10 Diving Championships in Federal Way, Wash. Dumais set Pac-10 records in all three events at the Championships. In the one-meter and three-meter events, Dumais broke his own Pac-10 records. In the platform, he broke the Pac-10 record of 817.90 set in 1994 by fellow Trojan Brian Earley with a final score of 823.95.

At the 1999 NCAA Swimming and Diving Championships, Dumais earned All-American honors following third place finishes in the one-meter and platform, and a fifth place finish in the three-meter. It is the second-straight year Dumais has won the Conference award.

Shaffer, in his four year at the helm of the USC diving program, led Pac-10 Diver of the Year Justin Dumais to three individual titles at the 1999 Pac-10 Diving Championships, as well as three Pac-10 records. Under Shaffer, USC claimed three of the top eight spots in all three diving finals at the Conference Championships. The Men's Coach of the Year award is the second of Shaffer's career, and second in as many years.

The Conference Diver and Coach of the Year awards are voted on by the coaches.

ARIZONA'S RYK NEETHLING AND CALIFORNIA'S NORT THORNTON NAMED 1998-99 PAC-10 MEN'S SWIMMER AND COACH OF THE YEAR

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- ARIZONA's Ryk Neethling and CALIFORNIA's Nort Thornton were named the 1998-99 Pacific-10 Conference Men's Swimmer and Coach of the Year, Commissioner Tom Hansen announced today.

Neethling, a 6-3 junior from Bloemfontein, South Africa, won individual NCAA Championships in the 200, 500 and 1,650-yard freestyle events in Indianapolis, Ind. With the wins, Neethling becomes only the eighth person in the 76-year history of the Championships to accomplish the double-triple (victories in three events in back-to-back seasons). His wins give him seven NCAA individual titles in three years. It was also the second straight year Neethling defended his 1,650 crown. At the 1999 Pac-10 Swimming Championships in Long Beach, Calif., Neethling successfully defended his Conference titles in the 500 and 1,650 freestyle. It was the third consecutive year that he won the 1,650 free.

This marks the third year in a row Neethling has been named Pac-10 Swimmer of the Year. Only Dave Wharton of USC and Bill Barrett of UCLA have won the award three years in row. Wharton garnered the honor four times (1988-91).

In his silver anniversary season at California, Thornton's Golden Bears came within eight points of ending Stanford's 17-year hold on the Pac-10 Championship. At the Conference championships, his swimmers won four individual and one relay title. Thornton also coached Bart Kizierowski to a title in the 100 freestyle, and the Bears to a fourth place finish at the 1999 NCAA Swimming and Diving Championships in Indianapolis, Ind. The Men's Coach of the Year award is the fourth of Thornton's career, and the first since he won three in a row (1978-80).

The Swimmer and Coach of the Year honors are determined by a coaches vote.
