## PAC-10 CONFERENCE MEN'S SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS THIS WEEK

**WHAT:** 2000 Pacific-10 Conference Men's Swimming Championships

**WHERE:** King County Aquatic Center, Federal Way, Wash.

**WHO:** Men's swimming teams from ARIZONA, ARIZONA STATE, CALIFORNIA, STANFORD, USC and WASHINGTON will compete for the 2000 Pac-10 Men's Swimming Championships.

**WHEN:** Thursday through Saturday, March 2-4, 2000; Preliminaries begin at 11 a.m. each morning and finals begin at 6 p.m. each evening.

**TICKETS:** Tickets for the 2000 Pacific-10 Conference Men's Swimming Championships will be available at the King County Aquatic Center on day of event only. A one-day pass is \$6 for adults and \$4 for students with ID or youths under 16 and seniors. An all sessions pass is \$15 for adults and \$10 for students, youths under 16 and seniors. Admission is free for the preliminary sessions.

**PAC-10 NOTES:** The 2000 Pac-10 Championships feature five of the top 11 schools in the country and four of the top six, according to the latest CSCA Top-25 poll – No. 2 ARIZONA, No. 4 CALIFORNIA, No. 5 USC, No. 6 STANFORD, and No. 11 ARIZONA STATE...Three 1999 Pac-10 Champions return to defend their titles in four events...Two 1999 NCAA individual champions will participate in the Conference Championships as well...Arizona senior, and three-time Pac-10 Swimmer of the Year, **Ryk Neethling** (200, 500 and 1,650 free) and California's **Bart Kizierowski** (100 free) are defending NCAA title-holders.

**ARIZONA:** The No. 2 Wildcats are seeking its first-ever Pac-10 championship this weekend...UA is led into the competition by seven-time NCAA, five-time Pac-10 Champion, and three-time Pac-10 Swimmer of the Year, **Ryk Neethling**...Neethling, a senior, is the defending Conference champ in the 500 and 1650 free...Neethling comes into the competition as the fastest 200, 500, and 1650 freestyler in the country...The Wildcats own several other top short course yards times...So. **Roland Schoeman** swam an NCAA record 19.07 seconds in the 50 free, Dec. 3 at Texas...Schoeman also has the nation's top time in the 100 free...Sr. **Matt Allen** has the nation's best mark in the 100 backstroke (47.85) and Jr. **Ben Anderson** has the best time in the 200 IM (1:47.52), as well as the No. 2 time in the 200 butterfly...UA has individuals in the top-10 in every event, except the 200 breaststroke and 100 butterfly...Arizona owns the nation's best times in the 200 medley relay and 200 freestyle relay.

**ARIZONA STATE:** ASU is ranked No. 11 in the latest CSCA poll...ASU has a solid corps of returners that should challenge to improve upon last year's fifth-place finish at the Pac-10s...Sr. **Pablo Abal** is ranked in the top-25 nationally in the 50 free (20.27), 100 back (48.97), and the 100 fly (48.48)...So. **Simon MacDonald** has three top-25 times as well – in the 50 free (20.03), 100 free (44.81), and the 100 fly (48.54)...Jr. **Austin Paulsen** had the best finish at Pac-10s among Sun Devil returnees, finishing in third place in the 400 IM...Jr. **Adam Guzauskas** should also challenge in the 100 breast, where he finished fourth last year...Also look for Jr. **Scott VonSchoff**, Fr. **Anders Lyrbring**, and So. **Bo West** to score points...The Devils have top-five times nationally in all the relays.

**CALIFORNIA:** The Cal Bears are ranked No. 4 nationally, and are led by four-time, including last year's, Pac-10 Coach of the Year in Nort Thornton...He will look to freestyle specialist **Bart Kizierowski** as one of the Golden Bears top hopes to bring home a Pac-10 Championship...A senior, Kizierowski is ranked in the top-5 nationally in the 50 (19.84) and 100 (43.63) free, as well as No. 15 in the 200 free (1:38.12)...He is the defending champion in the 50 free and finished second last year in the 200 free...Cal returns seven All-Americans in total, and fell just eight points short in last year's meet to Stanford...Fr. **Anthony Ervin** has top-10 times in both the 50 and 100 freestyle...So. **Andrew Chan** is expected to score in the breaststroke events...Chan is ranked among the top-six in the 100 (55.11) and 200 breast (1:00.66), with the Pac-10s best score in 2000 in the 200...Cal is ranked in the top-10 nationally in the 200 medley relay, 200 freestyle relay, and the 800 freestyle relay.

**STANFORD:** The Cardinal is defending its 18th consecutive Pac-10 Championships title, with possibly the toughest competition over those years...Stanford is ranked No. 6 entering the meet...The Cardinal graduated a highly experienced class last year, and this year's squad has just four seniors...Skip Kenney is in his 21st season at the helm on the Farm...One Pac-10 champion returns in 2000 in Jr. **Anthony Robinson** (100 breast)...Jr. **Adam Messner** is expected to score in the freestyle events...He has the nation's second-best score in the 200 free (1:36.33), and the seventh-best in the 500 free (4:24.44)...Also look for Fr. **Dan Westcott**, Fr. **Randall Bal**, Jr. **Rob Canales**, and Jr. **Steven Brown** to score significant points for the Cardinal...Canales and Brown both had top-three finishes in events last year...Stanford has the Pac-10's best 400 medley relay.

**USC:** USC enters the 2000 Pac-10s as the No. 5 team in the country according to CSCA...The Trojans finished second last year at the Pac-10 meet, and sixth at the NAAs...Seven All-Americans return for USC, led by So. **Mark Warkentin**...Warkentin is one of the top mid-to-distance freestylers in the country, having posted NCAA consideration times in the 400 (meters) free and 1650 free...So. **Nick Kaschik** finished fourth in the 200 IM and 400 IM at last year's meet...Jr. **Phil Demers** is the defending champion in the 200 fly...He is also a five-time All-American...Fr. **Erik Vendt** is ranked in the top-three nationally in the 500 free (4:20.48) and 1650 free (14:54.30)...Also look for Sr. **Bret Awbrey** in the 200 free and butterfly events, as well as Jr. **Leonardo Costa** in the backstroke...The Trojans have top-10 national times in the 400 and 800 freestyle relays.

**WASHINGTON:** Second-year coach Mickey Wender leads a young Husky team, swimming in their backyard pool in Federal Way...UW has only three seniors on its squad, with almost half of the roster comprised of first-year Huskies...Jr. **Francis Tam** has posted Washington's top individual times nationally...Tam is ranked in the 100 breast (14th, 55.78), 200 breast (8th, 2:01.25), and 200 IM (20th, 1:49.74)...Sr. **Bryan Nelson** has also posted national-ranking times in a couple of events - 1650 free (15th, 15:34.11) and 400 IM (24th, 3:57.55)... Nelson had the best finish for UW at last year's meet, coming in fifth place in the 1650 free...UW broke the school record in the 200 medley relay.

**LAST YEAR:** Stanford won its 18th consecutive Pac-10 Championship on the strength of three individual championships and three relay wins, as well as five individual second-place finishes. The Cardinal outlasted California in a tight race, 748.5-740.5.

**USC'S BRENNAN, ASU'S BRIGGS WIN TITLES ON FIRST DAY OF PAC-10 DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**LOS ANGELES** - USC sophomore Kellie Brennan successfully defended her title in the women's 1-meter springboard and Junior Marc Briggs of Arizona State won the men's 3-meter springboard on the first day of the Pacific-10 Conference Diving Championships on Thursday (Feb. 24) at the USC McDonald's Swim Stadium.

Brennan, who entered the finals in third place behind Stanford's Erin Sones and Arizona's Lindsay Berryman, leapfrogged them both to win the 1-meter with a score of 405.90. Sones was second with 405.68 while Berryman finished third with 395.06.

Briggs, in second place after the prelims, won the 3-meter event with 514.55 points. Arno Bergstrom of Arizona was second with 464.30 while Ruben Vaca of Arizona was third (461.75).

The meet continues Friday with the men's 1-meter and the women's three-meter. The meet concludes Saturday with the men's and women's platform. Each day's events begin at 10 a.m.

The overall team championships for Pac-10 Swimming and Diving include points from both the diving and swimming competitions. The Pac-10 Women's Swimming Championships are taking place Thursday through Saturday (Feb. 24-26) in Long Beach, Calif. The men's championships will be March 2-4 in Seattle, Wash.

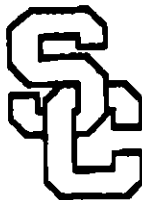

**ARIZONA'S VACA WINS 1-METER, STANFORD'S SONES WINS 3-METER AT PAC-10 DIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS**

**LOS ANGELES** - Arizona sophomore Ruben Vaca and Stanford junior Erin Sones both won titles on the second day of the Pacific-10 Conference Diving Championships on Friday (Feb. 25) at the USC McDonald's Swim Stadium.

Vaca, from Mexico City, won the men's 1-meter title with a score of 492.25. Arizona State's Marc Briggs, who won the 3-meter Thursday, finished second (489.85) and fellow Sun Devil Allan Sonkin was third (489.05).

Sones, from Pasadena, Calif., won the women's 3-meter title with a score of 486.67, followed by Arizona's Lindsay Berryman (485.94) and Cardinal teammate McKenzie Murphy (469.80).

The meet concludes Saturday with the men's and women's platform. Originally scheduled for 10 a.m., it will now begin at 9:30 a.m.

The overall team championships for Pac-10 Swimming and Diving include points from both the diving and swimming competitions. The Pac-10 Women's Swimming Championships are taking place Thursday through Saturday (Feb. 24-26) in Long Beach, Calif. The men's championships will be March 2-4 in Seattle, Wash.

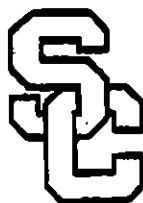

**LOS ANGELES** - Arizona men's sophomore Ruben Vaca and Arizona women's junior Lindsay Berryman swept the platform titles on the third and final day of the Pacific-10 Conference Diving Championships on Saturday (Feb. 26) at the USC McDonald's Swim Stadium.

Vaca, from Mexico City who won the men's 1-meter title on Friday, won the platform with a score of 461.75. The next closest competitor was Arizona State's Marc Briggs, who had 408.00

**Texas Wins Div. I Men's Swimming & Diving Championship**

MINNEAPOLIS (AP) - Texas failed to win an individual event Saturday, but the Longhorns had already piled up enough points to capture the NCAA men's swimming and diving team championship.

Texas racked up 538 points to win its seventh national team championship and first since 1996. Auburn was runner-up with a score of 385, the fifth straight year the Tigers came in first or second in the NCAA. Arizona came in third with 360.5, and Stanford fourth with 279.5.

"We came in here with a pretty good team the last three years," said Texas coach Eddie Reese. "As they've gotten older, they've swam better each year. This has been an enjoyable trip."

Arizona's Ryk Neethling was upset in his bid for a fourth straight title in the 1500-meter freestyle. Erik Vendt won with a time of 14:31.02, beating out Chris Thompson of Michigan by nearly five seconds. Neethling, who won the 200-meter and 400-meter freestyles earlier in the week, was third at 14:39.04.

"I know he was the defending champion," said Vendt of Neethling. "I wasn't thinking about those titles. I was thinking about winning the race."

Neethling was also denied his 10th career NCAA championship. Only two other swimmers have reached that figure, John Naber of Southern Cal (10) and Pablo Morales of Stanford (11).

Ed Moses won his second title of the week by finishing first in the 200-meter breaststroke with a world record 2:06.40. The sophomore from Virginia won the 100-meter breaststroke on Friday.

Anthony Ervin of California captured his second title of the meet by outlasting a crowded field to win the 100-meter freestyle. Ervin's time of :47.36 seconds was a fraction of a second ahead of second-place Roland Schoeman of Arizona. The top five finishers were separated by just one second.

Ervin also won the 50-meter freestyle championship.

Florida's Matt Cole swam the 200-meter backstroke in 1:53.68 to take the championship. Adam Messner of Stanford won the 200-meter butterfly title with a time of 1:55.79.

The platform diving championship went to Miami's Tyce Routson, who scored 596.10. Troy Dumais of Texas, who won the 1-meter and 3-meter titles, finished second with 588.80.

**Arizona Men's Swimming and Diving Finishes Third at 2000 NCAA Championships**

MINNEAPOLIS, Minn. - In the biggest upset of the weekend, senior Ryk Neethling fell short in his bid to win his third individual crown of the weekend and 10th career title on the final day of competition today at the University Aquatic Center, as Arizona finished in third-place (360.5 points) at the 2000 NCAA Men's Swimming and Diving Championships. The third-place finish also marked the best finish in school history for the men's program. The previous best was a fourth-place finish by the 1993 squad.

Texas brought home its seventh NCAA men's championship with 538 points, while defending-champion Auburn placed second (385). Stanford (fourth place; 279.5 points) and California (279) round out the top five.

Event 15, the 1,500-meter freestyle, saw Neethling race side by side with Michigan's Chris Thompson and USC's Eric Vendt for most of the race, before faltering late and finishing third (14:39.04). Vendt captured the title in an American-record time of 14:31.02, followed by Thompson (14:35.95). Neethling (14:39.04) finished his collegiate career with nine individual titles, placing him in a five-way tie for third-best all-time. Neethling was attempting to become only the third man in the 77-year history of the NCAA Men's Championships to win three event titles in three-straight years. Another strong performance for the Cats in the 1,500m free came from senior Nat Lewis who finished fifth, in a time of 14:57.01. That swim also earned Lewis the seventh All-America nod of his career.

In the second event of day three, the 200m backstroke, sophomore Kris Souther scored 14 points for Arizona by turning in a fifth-place performance (1:55.51). Senior Matt Allen qualified 16th in the event, only after defeating Stanford's Randall Bal in a swim-off because both swimmers qualified in a time of 1:57.72. In the evening consolation finals Allen finished 15th (1:58.33).

In the 100m freestyle, sophomore Roland Schoeman (47.51) placed second to California's Anthony Ervin (47.36). The duo also finished in the same order in the 50m freestyle, providing a possible preview to the finals at the Olympic Games this summer. Scoring points for the Cats in the consolation final was senior Coley Stickels (13th place; 49.08) and junior Jay Schryver (15th place; 49.31).

In the 200m butterfly UA freshman Jeff Dash advanced to his first-ever championship final and made the most of it. Dash placed fifth, in a time of 1:57.01. Junior Ben Anderson swam in the consolation final, placing 10th overall (1:58.65).

Next, the swimmers took a break while the men's 10-Meter Platform diving competition took place. Sophomore Ruben Vaca finished 17th (403.50 points) and junior Arno Bergstrom placed 19th (387.25).

The final event of the final day saw the 400m free relay squad of Schoeman, Stickels, Schryver and Neethling place third, in a time of 3:13.18. The race picked up 32 points for the Wildcats.

## ARIZONA SWEEPS MEN'S DIVING AWARDS RUBEN VACA NAMED MEN'S DIVER AND NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR MICHELLE MITCHELL-ROCHA NAMED COACH OF THE YEAR

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. – ARIZONA's **Ruben Vaca** has been named Pacific-10 Conference Men's Diver and Newcomer of the Year, while **Michelle Mitchell-Rocha** has been named Coach of the Year, Commissioner Tom Hansen announced today.

Vaca, a sophomore from Mexico City, Mexico, claimed two of the three individual diving events at the Pac-10 Diving Championships in Los Angeles, California. ## **ARIZONA'S RYK NEETHLING NAMED MEN'S SWIMMER OF THE YEAR CALIFORNIA'S ANTHONY ERVIN NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR AND ARIZONA'S FRANK BUSCH COACH OF THE YEAR**

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- ARIZONA's Ryk Neethling has been named Men's Swimmer of the Year, CALIFORNIA's Anthony Ervin Newcomer of the Year, and ARIZONA's Frank Busch has been named Coach of the Year, Commissioner Tom Hansen announced today.

Neethling, a 6-3 senior from Bloemfontein, South Africa, closed out his storied career with individual titles at the NCAA Championships in the 200- and 400-meter freestyle events, both U.S. Open records, while finishing third in the 1,650-yard freestyle in Minneapolis, Minn. His wins give him nine NCAA individual titles for his career, third-best in NCAA history. He racked up a remarkable 56 points, second-best among individuals. At the Pac-10 Swimming Championships in Federal Way, Wash., Neethling successfully defended his Conference titles in the 500 and 1,650 freestyle. It was the fourth consecutive year that he won the 1,650 free and third consecutive year winning the 500 free.

This marks the fourth year in a row Neethling has been named Pac-10 Swimmer of the Year. The feat matches Dave Wharton of USC who is the only other swimmer to ever garner the honor four times (1988-91).

Ervin, a 6-2 freshman from Valerica, Calif., won two individual NCAA titles in the 50- and 100-meter freestyle events, as well as swimming a leg on the winning 400-meter freestyle relay team at this year's NCAA Championships. Ervin became the first Bear to win more than one individual title since 1997. He broke the World Record in the 50 free with a time of 21.21 seconds. He also set a U.S. Open record in the 100 free with a time of 47.36. At the Pac-10 Championships, Ervin swam on the winning 200 and 400 freestyle relay teams. He had two second place markings in the 50 and 100 free.

Busch, has been named Coach of the Year for the second time (1993) in his 11-year career and fifth time overall (men's and women's swimming combined). Busch was named the Women's Swimming Coach of the Year for 2000 earlier today. It is the first time in Pac-10 history that a swimming coach has earned both honors in the same season. The women's award has been given since 1987 and the men's began in 1976. Busch's Wildcats finished third at the NCAA Championships, marking the best finish in school history for the men's program. Arizona placed fourth at the Pac-10 Championships.

The awards are determined by a vote of the coaches.
